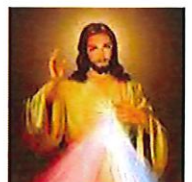

I will again offer Atrium time for the children 3-9 years. For 3-6 age children, the parent or another adult will need stay with the child. The atrium will be offered by appointment only. If interested please contact me at the parish office by leaving a message and I will return your call.

Please return the survey you received, or it can be found on the website, as this will determine when our Faith Formation classes will be held for the following years.

For any new families interested please contact me, especially if your child is eligible to receive the sacraments. Confirmation is starting this fall for youth 12 years old and attending 7th grade. We are pairing with Bad Axe for the confirmation program. Yesu, Bad Axe, to determine if your child is ready to complete the sacrament of Confirmation, it's a 2 year program.
