The faith formation, year-end class will be Tuesday April 29th, after school and ending 5:00 PM. I want to Thank all the Parents who provided snacks this year, and for the notices of when your children would be absent. Again Thank you all. Letters will be sent providing the new schedule.

I will again offer Atrium time for the children 3-9 years. For 3-6 age children, the parent or another adult will need stay with the child. The atrium will be offered by appointment only. If interested please contact me at the parish office by leaving a message and I will return your call.

Please return the survey you received, or it can be found on the website, as this will determine when our Faith Formation classes will be held for the following years.

For any new families interested please contact me, especially if your child is eligible to receive the sacraments. If your child is going to receive sacraments (Reconciliation and First Eucharist) in the year they are 2nd graders please contact me when they enter 1st grade. It is important since the program requires a 2 year program.

Confirmation is starting this fall for youth 12 years old and attending 7th grade. We are pairing with Bad Axe for the confirmation program. For more information contact Verna Murawski, as we will have to determine with an interview by Fr. Craig or Fr. Yesu, Bad Axe, to determine if your child is ready to complete the sacrament of Confirmation, it's a 2 year program.
