FAITH FORMATION:

For any new families interested in enrolling your child in our Faith Formation program please contact me, especially if your child is eligible to receive the sacraments. If your child is going to receive sacraments (Reconciliation and First Eucharist) in the year they are 2nd graders please contact me when they enter 1st grade. It is important since the program requires a 2 year program.

Confirmation is starting this fall for youth 12 years old and attending 7th grade. We are pairing with Bad Axe for the confirmation program. For more information contact Verna Murawski, as we will have to determine with an interview by Fr. Craig or Fr. Yesu, Bad Axe, to determine if your child is ready to complete the sacrament of Confirmation, it's a 2 year program.
