Home Enthronement Program

Enthronement of the Sacred Heart and Immaculate Heart is a Catholic devotion recognizing Jesus Christ as the King and Head of a home and family, and Mary, his mother as Queen.

It involves consecrating the family to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, recognizing her as a powerful intercessor and spiritual mother. Mary is seen as leading us to her son, Jesus & Her Immaculate Heart as a source of grace and protection. It is done concurrently with the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart.

This dual devotion aims to sanctify the home and family by inviting Jesus and Mary into homes seeking their blessings, protection and guidance in daily lives.

This practice is intended to remind demons that the home is ruled by Christ with Mary to protect the home from worldly obsessions, push back negative influences, and create a space for God's grace to flourish.

A few years ago, Bishop Gruss changed the age to prepare for Confirmation to starting around 12 years old. In the Fall of 2024, preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation through the **Life Teen Purpose Program** began in the Diocese of Saginaw.

Purpose will consist of two years of preparation. The first year is focused on your child having a personal encounter with Jesus, and to decide whether they want to be Confirmed. The second year will be focused on preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation and experiencing more of the Holy Spirit in their life. Your child will also be required to participate in service projects.

Our **Purpose** program will begin on **Wednesday, September 10th from 3:30-5:30pm. at St. Hubert Parish (Sacred Heart Church) in Bad Axe.** It will consist of two classes each month. Occasionally, parents will be asked to attend, especially for the first class on September 10th.
