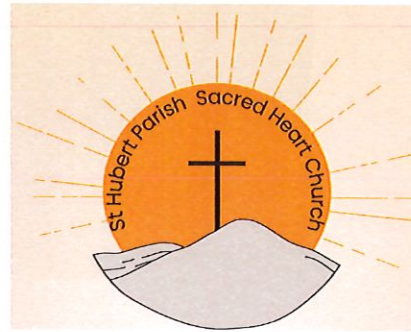
**Hello Pro-lifers,**
